Policies:

All our policies are designed to offer the best possible experiences for the children and families and are readily available on request. Our policies cover a range such as child protection, confidentiality, behaviour and anti bullying, complaints procedure, inclusion, settling in, parental involvement etc to mention a few.

Our payment policy allows for flexibility of sessions booked. In relation to anti bullying, we encourage the children against bullying, carry out observations, discuss and resolve conflicts immediately they occur, report the incident and note the record of action to be taken. In addition to these, the children made up extra rules, discussed, agreed and adhered to by both adults and children.

Refreshment/Snacks:

We support the Medway Healthy Schools schemes and therefore offer healthy breakfast and snacks. Parents are advised to provide such in lunch boxes where children stay for a whole day or lunch time sessions (12noon) during the holiday scheme. We offer the choice of milk, dried fruits, fresh fruits/vegetables, water, pancakes, smoothies, toast, English muffins, crumpets, fromage frais, dips, breadsticks, crackers and bread rolls with various fillings. During breakfast club, there is a choice of cereal, bread, spread, fresh juice, water and milk. **Treat days** take place twice a term in answer to children's survey. On offer additionally are waffles, pancakes, croissant, chocolate spread, honey and hot cocoa or milk

We do not offer or recommend fizzy drinks. Please keep us informed of any particular dietary requirements your child may have.

Activities:
